ALLEGANY COUNTY COVID POSITIVITY RATE AND VACCINATION STATS

CUMBERLAND, MD – The Allegheny County Health Department reports that 23,387 Allegheny County residents have received their first dose of a two-dose vaccine against COVID-19 (33.2% of the population), with 19,158 of those individuals now fully vaccinated with their second dose (27.2 % of the population). The number of residents who have received the single-dose Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) vaccine is 2,253 (3.2 %).

By comparison, the state reported that 48.3% of all Marylanders had received their first dose of a two-dose vaccine, with 36.8% having had both doses and 3.4% vaccinated with the single-dose vaccine.

Allegheny County COVID-19 Case Statistics as of May 11:

- New COVID Cases: 8 (cumulative total 6,906)
- Additional Deaths: 0 (cumulative total 207)
- Cases Per 100,000 Population: 7.71 (*Maryland: 8.46*)
- Positivity Rate: 2.42 % (*Maryland: 2.74%*)

A walk-in COVID-19 vaccination clinic will be held at the Allegheny County Fairgrounds multipurpose building on May 13 from 9 a.m. to noon and 1 to 3 p.m. No appointment is necessary. Both the Moderna and Johnson & Johnson COVID vaccines will be offered. Another walk-in clinic, also at the fairgrounds from 9 a.m. to noon and 1 to 3 p.m., is slated for Thursday, May 20. Additional clinics will be announced as they are scheduled.
