Renewal Who

If your license expires on May 31, 2024 ITS YOUR TIME! Are you ready to validate your credentials for two more years? I know most of you have mastered the process but if you need a renewal process refresher keep reading.

Renewal Cost & When

- Early Renewal is April 1st 30th. The fee is \$551.
- Standard Renewal is May 1st 31st. The fee is \$551.
- Late Renewal (a.k.a. grace period) is June 1st 30th. The fee is \$651.
- Post-Expiration Renewal (a.k.a Reinstatement) is anytime after June 30th. The fee is \$751.
- Inactive Status requests must be received and processed by June 30th. The fee is \$100

The Board's office (the entire third floor) will be getting some TLC during the month of April. This means that access to paper records will be limited.

Renewal Musts & Whats

- The <u>Continuing Education</u> reporting period is June 1, 2022 May 31, 2024. A total of 30 CEUs must be reported..
- Renewal is an online only process. No paper applications are being accepted.
- All payments must be made via credit or debit card (Mastercard or Visa). **No** checks or money orders are being accepted.
- Licensees selected to participate in the renewal audit **must** submit proof of completed continuing education by email, fax or mail before their license is approved for renewal.

 ALL Maryland State health professions Licensees must comply with the one-time requirement to complete an <u>implicit bias training course</u>.

Renewal How & Where

- To access the <u>online renewal portal</u> visit the <u>Board's website</u>. <u>Renew Your License</u> is in the vertical menu on the left. Once your application is reviewed and your submission is approved, the website's <u>Verify A License</u> page will be updated.
- Visit the <u>Verify A License</u> page on the Board's website to obtain immediate proof of renewal. This
 page can be printed or saved to a device. The Board ceased printing licenses in 2021, however the
 Board will issue one (1) printed version of this page (Proof of Practice/License Verification
 Certificate) after the renewal period ends.
- To access the *inactive status* instructions, form and payment link, go to the <u>Apply for a License</u> tab on the Board's website and scroll down to <u>Licensees Seeking Inactive Status</u>. You can also access <u>Renewing Licenses</u> on this page.

Update Contact Information and Credentials

 The Board sends correspondence to Licensees by email and mail. The Board may also call Licensees from time to time. Licensees are **required** to ensure that the Board has their most upto-date contact information. Failure to comply can result in a \$50 fine. This contact information must distinguish between personal and professional information, as the Board provides Licensees' professional information - including name, address and contact number - in response to roster or Freedom of Information/Public Information Act requests. If no business information is provided, the release will default to the Licensees' personal information.

Renewal season is an ideal time to update your personal and professional information while completing the online renewal application. You can also submit contact information changes to the Board anytime by email, fax or mail.

Are you licensed in more than one profession or State? Have you earned another health professions certificate or degree? Renewal is also an ideal time to share this information with the Board as well. Proof of your accomplishments (e.g., certificate, degree, license or transcript) can be submitted to the Board anytime by email, fax or mail.
