John Chapman is a member of The Bristlecone Project. He was one of 200 men who participated in Oprah Winfrey's 2010 show that highlighted male survivors of childhood sexual abuse. John joined an Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force, and tracked down sexual predators by posing online as a young boy, and then located, arrested and helped to prosecute the predators.



Robert Zellner had 31 court cases, 52 charges, 10 convictions, and over 15 times in a jumpsuit for over the past 13 years. "I am an ex-drug dealer and ex-gang member turned addict. All I want to do now is help the community I've helped destroy for the past 16 years, help addicts and children to not have to take the route I did."



Featured in the documentary "Understanding Joy" A woman whose gambling addiction had driven her to embezzle over \$700,000 during a seven year period from two employers. Joy has struggled to explain her disease to her children, to the world and to understand it herself. Now in recovery, we get to hear her story of resilience.



Danny Sterling found out after a radical orchiectomy, last June 2016 that he had stage 1b testicular cancer. At the age of 25 this was something that completely rattled his life. During his recovery, he researched all that he could on healing his body through nutrition in hopes to come back better than before. He now hopes to use this experience as a platform to share what he has learned about disease prevention through nutrition.
