**ORDER TERMINATING SUSPENSION AND REINSTATING HEARING AID  
DISPENSER LIMITED LICENSE**

On or about July 8, 2019 the Maryland State Board of Examiners for Audiologists, Hearing Aid Dispensers and Speech-Language Pathologists (the “Board”) issued an Order of Suspension of the Hearing Aid Dispenser Limited License, for Delinquent Child Support (“Order of Suspension”) against Tyree Antonio Huddleston, Limited License Number 02813 (the “Respondent”). Pursuant to Maryland Family Law Code Ann (“Fam. Law”) 10-119.3 (e)(2)(i) (2012 Repl. Vol and 2017 Supp.), upon request of the Baltimore City Office of Child Support Enforcement Administration of the Maryland Department of Human Services (the “Administration”), the Board suspended Respondent’s limited license to practice as a hearing aid dispenser in Maryland for Respondent’s delinquent child support payments.

On September 30, 2019, the Board received a Notice to Reinstate Respondent’s limited license from the Administration. Pursuant to the Maryland State Examiners for Audiologists, Hearing Aid Dispensers and Speech-Language Pathologists Act, Maryland Code Ann., Health Occupations Art., §§ 20-101, *et seq.*, Respondent otherwise qualifies for a hearing aid dispenser limited license.


Therefore, based upon the foregoing, it is hereby:

**ORDERED** that the suspension of the limited license of the Respondent, Tyree Antonio Huddleston, Limited License Number 02813, to practice as a hearing aid dispenser is hereby **TERMINATED**; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the hearing aid dispenser limited license of the Respondent, Tyree Antonio Huddleston, Limited License Number 02813 is **REINSTATED** without restrictions or conditions; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this a Final Decision and Order of the Board and, as such, is a **PUBLIC DOCUMENT** pursuant to Maryland Code Ann., General Provisions Art., §§ 4-101 *et seq.*
