# PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

The Maryland State Board of Morticians and Funeral Directors (the "Board") and Cecil A. Estep (the "Respondent") have agreed, in lieu of the Board's filing formal charges, to enter into to this Pre-Charge Consent Order (the "Order"). The Respondent waives his right to a hearing and agrees to be sanctioned by the Board. This Order is based upon the Board's belief that the Respondent violated provisions of the Maryland Morticians and Funeral Directors Act ("the Act"), Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. ("H.O.") §§ 7-101 et seq. (2009 Repl. Vol.).

## FINDINGS OF FACT

- At all times relevant, the Respondent was and is licensed to practice mortuary science in the State of Maryland under license number M00190.
- At all times relevant, the Respondent was and is the Supervising Mortician at Estep Funeral Service, P.A. located at 1300 Eutaw Place in Baltimore City.
- 3. The Board launched an investigation upon receiving a complaint from Family A<sup>1</sup> that, in spite of having made arrangements with the Respondent for embalming, viewing and a service for their deceased family member<sup>2</sup>, the Respondent cremated the deceased before the viewing.
- 4. When the deceased's daughter arrived for a viewing she was shown a picture of him dressed in his suit and told that he had already been cremated.
- 5. The unsigned at need contract was in the amount of \$4,078.00 which included the removal

fee of \$275.00 and embalming fee of \$825.00.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Board finds that the Respondent violated H.O. §§ 7-316(a)(14) and (26).

#### ORDER

ORDERED that the Respondent shall be placed on PROBATION for a period of one (1) year to commence on the effective date<sup>3</sup> of this Consent Order (the "Order"); and it is further

ORDERED that no later than thirty (30) days from the effective date of this Order the Respondent shall reimburse Family A two thousand nine hundred and seventy eight dollars (\$2978.00)<sup>4</sup>; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the Board shall conduct quarterly unannounced inspections of the Respondent's funeral home over the course of the Respondent's probation; and it is further

ORDERED that no earlier than one (1) year from the effective date of this Order, the

Respondent may petition the Board for termination of his probationary status. It shall be within the

Board's discretion to grant such a request; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the Respondent shall be responsible for all costs incurred under this Order; and it is further

ORDERED that the Respondent shall comply with and practice within all statutes and regulations governing the practice of mortuary science and funeral direction in the State of Maryland; and it is further

ORDERED that any violation of the terms and conditions of this Order shall constitute
