ORDER OF TERMINATION OF PROBATION


On or about January 13, 2016, the Maryland State Board of Morticians and Funeral Directors (the “Board”) executed a “Consent Order of Suspension/Probation,” which, among other things, placed Cullen Harris, license number M01341 (the “Petitioner”) on probation for a minimum of six (6) months subject to certain probationary terms and conditions. On or about November 30, 2016, the Petitioner petitioned the Board to terminate the probation upon his license. The Board considered the Petition and has decided to terminate the probation imposed by the January 13, 2016 Order based upon the Petitioner’s satisfactory compliance with the probationary terms set forth in that Order.

Wherefore, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the probation and all associated terms and conditions imposed upon Cullen Harris, license number M01341, as set forth in the “Consent Order of Suspension/Probation” dated January 13, 2016 are hereby **LIFTED AND TERMINATED** and those terms and conditions have no further force and effect; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a Final Decision and Order of the Maryland State Board of Morticians and Funeral Directors and as such is a **PUBLIC DOCUMENT** pursuant to Md. Code Ann., General Provisions §§ 4-101 *et seq.*
