ORDER OF TERMINATION OF PROBATION


On or about January 14, 2015, the Maryland State Board of Morticians and Funeral Directors (the "Board") executed a "Consent Order of Reprimand and Probation," which placed Breta London, license number M01609 (the "Petitioner") on probation for a minimum of two (2) years subject to certain probationary terms and conditions. On or about December 12, 2016, the Petitioner petitioned the Board to terminate the probation upon her license. The Board considered the Petition and has decided to terminate the probation imposed by the January 14, 2015 Order based upon the Petitioner's compliance with the probationary terms set forth in that Order.

Wherefore, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the probationary terms and conditions imposed upon Breta London, license number M01609, as set forth in the "Consent Order of Reprimand and Probation" dated January 14, 2015 are hereby **LIFTED AND TERMINATED** and those terms and conditions of no further force and effect; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a Final Decision and Order of the Maryland State Board of Morticians and Funeral Directors and as such is a **PUBLIC DOCUMENT** pursuant to Md. Code Ann., General Provisions §§ 4-101 *et seq.*
