**ORDER LIFTING SUSPENSION AND
REINSTATING MORTUARY TRANSPORTER REGISTRATION**

On or about March 2 2016, the Maryland Board of Morticians and Funeral Directors (the “Board”) issued a “Final Order of Suspension of Mortuary Transporter Registration for Delinquent Child Support” (“Order of Suspension”) against William Wilson, Registration Number T0084 (the “Respondent”). Pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Family Law Article (“Fam. Law”) § 10.119.3(e)(2)(i), upon request of the Montgomery County Office of Child Support Enforcement Administration of the Maryland Department of Human Resources (the “Administration”), the Board suspended the Respondent’s license to practice as a registered mortuary transporter in the State of Maryland due to the Respondent’s delinquent child support payments.

On January 24, 2017, the Board received a “Notice to Reinstate Professional License” from the Administration. Pursuant to the Maryland Morticians and Funeral Directors Act, Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. §§ 7-101 *et seq.*, the Respondent otherwise qualifies for a registration so long as he notifies the Board of which mortuary transport service in the State of Maryland he is employed.

Therefore, pursuant to Fam. Law § 10-119.3(k), it is:

ORDERED that the suspension of the Respondent’s registration to practice as a mortuary transporter in the State of Maryland is hereby **LIFTED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the license of the Respondent to registration as a mortuary transporter in the State of Maryland is **REINSTATED** without restrictions or conditions; and it is further

ORDERED that, before the Respondent may practice as a registered mortuary transporter, he must notify the Board of which licensed mortuary transport service he is employed by; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a Final Decision and Order of the Maryland Board of Morticians and Funeral Directors and, as such, is a **PUBLIC DOCUMENT** pursuant to Maryland Code Ann., General Provisions § 4-101 *et seq.*
