Ms. Stevanne Ellis notified the Board that SB 665, sponsored by the President of the Office of the Attorney General, would possibly be introduced this session. Ms. Ellis urged the Board to review the bill because the bill focuses on unlicensed assisted living programs, and it may have a possible impact on Maryland assisted living managers as they will be required to be licensed under our Board by October 1, 2024.
