The Counseling Compact Commission has opened a public comment period for the following proposed and amended rules:

- Chapter 2 – Definitions (Amended)
- Chapter 11 – Military Identification Submission, Audit Practices, and Revocation Procedure
 - Chapter 12 – Term of Office
 - Chapter 13 – Mediation and Binding Dispute Resolution
- Chapter 14 – Counseling Compact Commission Joint Investigations
 - Chapter 15 – Grounds for Compact Privilege Termination

Public Comment Deadline: September 13, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. Mountain Time.

A public hearing will be held if requested by at least 25 persons; a state or federal governmental subdivision or agency; or an association with at least 25 members. Hearing requests must be submitted in accordance with the Commission's instructions.
