**ORDER OF TERMINATION OF PROBATION**

**WHEREAS**, on February 18, 2022, the Maryland Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists (“the Board”) issued an Order which placed ANNETTE ROYER’s (“the Respondent’s) license to practice as a Certified Associate Counselor – Alcohol and Drug (“CAC-AD”) in the State of Maryland under Probation for a minimum period of 12 months.

**WHEREAS**, the Respondent filed a Petition for Termination of Probation and Reactivation of Supervision (“Petition”);

**WHEREAS**, on May 17, 2024, the Board considered the Respondent’s Petition; and


**WHEREAS**, upon receiving of satisfactory evidence that the Respondent has successfully completed the conditions of probation and complied with all other terms set forth in the February 18, 2022 Order, a quorum of the Board voted to grant the Respondent’s Petition, pursuant to the Health Occupations Article (“HO”) § 17-505(b); and. It is therefore:

**ORDERED**, that the probation on Respondent’s license to practice as a CAC-AD is hereby **TERMINATED**; and it is also

**ORDERED** that this is a final order and therefore a public document pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Gen. Provisions §§4-101 *et seq.*(2024).
