**ORDER FOR TERMINATION OF PROBATION**

The Maryland Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists (the “Board”) charged the Respondent, Jeff Biele, LCPC, License Number LC8069, with violating various provisions of the Maryland Professional Counselors and Therapists Act, codified at Md. Code Ann., Health. Occ. §§ 17-101 *et seq.* (2021).

On January 20, 2023, the Board executed a Consent Order that imposed a reprimand on the Respondent and placed his license to practice as a clinical professional counselor on Probation Status for a minimum of two (2) years along with specific terms and conditions.

After careful review and consideration of the Respondent’s Petition to Terminate Probation, the Board finds that the Respondent has successfully complied with and completed all of the terms and conditions imposed by the January 20, 2023, Consent Order.

**WHEREFORE**, it is on this 21<sup>st</sup> day of March 2025, by a majority vote of the Board:

**ORDERED** that the Probationary status of the Respondent’s license and specified terms and conditions imposed by the January 20, 2023, Consent Order are hereby **TERMINATED** and are of no further force or effect; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this **ORDER FOR TERMINATION OF PROBATION** is a Public Document pursuant to Maryland Code Ann., Gen. Prov. §4- 333(b)(7).
