CONSENT ORDER

Background

On March 16, 2012, the Maryland State Board of Professional Counselors & Therapists (the "Board") received information concerning the practice of Professional Counseling of Karen Maynor, the Respondent, alleging that the Respondent was practicing Professional Counseling without a license. The Board subsequently opened an investigation in this matter.

On August 14, 2013, the Respondent and her attorney, Kathy Mancusi, attended a settlement conference with Board representatives in an effort to reach resolution of the case prior to the issuance of charges. As a result, the Respondent and the Board have agreed to resolve this matter as set forth in this Consent Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Board finds that:

1. On March 16, 2012, the Board received information concerning the practice of Professional Counseling of Karen Maynor alleging that the Respondent practiced Professional Counseling without a license at Facility A.
2. In the course of its investigation, the Board established that the Respondent practiced Professional Counseling without a license from February, 2011 until July, 2011.
3. In an interview with Board representatives, the Respondent, Karen Maynor, disclosed that she provided professional counseling without a license during her period of employment at Facility A.

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CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Board concludes that the Respondent, Karen Maynor, in violation of Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 17-301, § 17-509 (7), (8), (9), (13) and (16), § 17-601 and COMAR 10.58.03.04 (A)(11) and (B)(2). These violations are based upon the fact that the Respondent practiced Professional Counseling for six months.

ORDER

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, it is this 28th day of DATE March, 2014, hereby:


REPRIMAND

I sign this Consent Order voluntarily, without reservation, and I fully understand and comprehend the language, meaning and terms of this Consent Order, consisting of 4 pages.

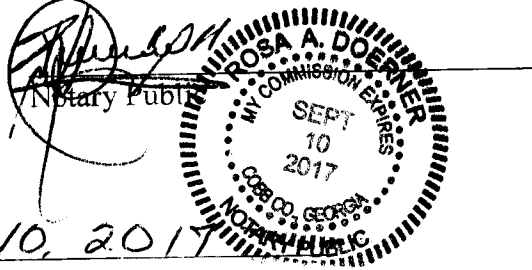
