Chapter 05 Collection of Fees

Authority: Health Occupations Article. §§10.205 and 10-20G, Annotated Code of Maryland

.01 Fees.

The fees established by the Board are as follows:

- A. Address change, failure to notify the Board - \$50;
- B. Application for initial licensure (includes first temporary license and is nonrefundable) - \$200;
- C. Application for second temporary license - \$50;
- D. Continuing Competency Provider Contact Hour review - \$30;
- E. Insufficient funds - \$35;
- F. Reactivation of license after elective nonrenewal - \$245;
- G. Reinstatement - \$450;
- H. Elective nonrenewal - \$25;
- I. Renewal, late fee (applicable to renewal made after the renewal deadline) - \$100;
- J. Renewal, occupational therapist license - \$270
- K. Renewal, occupational therapy assistant license - \$210; and
- L. Verification of licensure - \$20
- M. Interstate occupational therapy licensure compact fee - \$125

.02 Assessment for Health Care Professionals.

At the time of license renewal an occupational therapist shall pay a fee for health care professionals assessed by the Maryland Health Care Commission (MHCC), as specified in COMAR 10.25.02.
