# **CONSENT ORDER OF REPRIMAND AND FINE**

On July 8, 2021, Amy Kuhl ("Respondent") emailed the Maryland Board of Occupational Therapy Practice (the "Board") inquiring about the status of her license to practice occupational therapy, License Number 07788, in the State of Maryland. The Respondent advised she did not see her license listed as renewed on the Board's website. The Board had no record at that time of the Respondent renewing her license. The Respondent subsequently submitted an application and payment to reinstate her expired license.

Based on the Board's investigation into the Respondent's conduct, including a written response through counsel to the Board on March 18, 2022, the Board voted on April 15, 2022 to offer a Consent Order of Reprimand to the Respondent, in lieu of issuing Charges for violating the Maryland Occupational Therapy Practice Act (the "Act"), Md. Code Ann., Health Occupations Article ("H.O.") §§ 10-101 et seq. As a result of that offer, the Respondent and the Board agreed to the following Consent Order.



#### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

#### The Board finds that:

- 1. On September 21, 2015, the Board issued the Respondent a license to practice as an Occupational Therapist in the State of Maryland, License Number 07788.
- 2. The Respondent failed to renew her license during the timely renewal period for Occupation Therapy licenses between May 1, 2021 to May 31, 2021.
- 3. The Respondent also failed to renew her license during the grace period for renewals between June 1, 2021 to June 30, 2021.
  - 4. The Respondent's license expired on June 30, 2021.
- 5. The Respondent contacted the Board on July 8, 2021 with concerns her license did not appear as "renewed" on the Board's website.
- 6. The Board had no record of the Respondent submitting an application for renewal of her license during the 2021 renewal window, nor the grace period following the renewal window.
- 7. The Respondent subsequently applied for reinstatement with the Board and indicated in a July 14, 2021 e-mail to the Board that she had not worked between June 30, 2021 and July 14, 2021.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> (f) The Board shall renew the license of an occupational therapist or an occupational therapy assistant who has failed to renew the license for any reason if the occupational therapist or occupational therapy assistant:

<sup>(1)</sup> Applies for renewal within 30 days after the deadline for renewal;

<sup>(2)</sup> Meets the renewal requirements of this section;

<sup>(3)</sup> Pays to the Board the renewal fee set by the Board; and

<sup>(4)</sup> Pays to the Board the late fee set by the Board.

8. In a written statement submitted to the Board through Counsel, the Respondent later admitted to treating four patients between July 13 and July 14, 2021 while her application for reinstatement was pending.

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Based on the foregoing findings of fact, the Board concludes that the Respondent violated the following provisions of the Act:

Md. Code Ann., Health Occ Art..

§10-401(a): Except as otherwise provided in this title, a person may not practice, attempt to practice, or offer to practice occupational therapy in this State unless licensed by the Board to practice occupational therapy by the Board.

§10-402(a): Unless authorized to practice occupational therapy under this title or unless otherwise provided for under this article, a person may not represent to the public by title, by description of services, methods, or procedures, or otherwise that the person is authorized to practice occupational therapy in this State.

The Board also concludes that by practicing occupational therapy without a license the Respondent violated Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 10-315, which allows the Board to "...reprimand any licensee" who:

(5) Violates any rule or regulation of the Board, including any code of ethics adopted by the Board[.]



#### **ORDER**

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, it is hereby:

**ORDERED** that the license of the Respondent to practice as an occupational therapist in the State of Maryland is hereby **REPRIMANDED**; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the Respondent shall comply with the Maryland Occupational Therapy Practice Act, Md. Code Ann. Health Occ. §§ 10-101 *et seq.*, and all Federal and State laws and regulations governing the practice of occupational therapy in Maryland; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this is a Final Decision and Order of the Board and, as such, is a **PUBLIC DOCUMENT** pursuant to Maryland Code Ann., General Provisions § 4-101 *et seq*.
