ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On April 26, 2023 the Maryland Board of Occupational Therapy Practice (the "Board") received a complaint regarding Hannah Williams (the "Respondent"). On May 2, 2023 the Board and the Respondent entered into a Consent Order of Reprimand (the "Consent Order").

The Consent Order placed the Respondent's license on Probation for a minimum of two (2) years.

On May 15, 2026 the Board considered the Respondent's petition to lift and terminate probation.

Based on the Respondent's petition and the Board's finding the Respondent complied with the terms and conditions of the Probation, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the probationary terms and conditions imposed upon the license of Hannah Williams, Lic. No.: A02601, to practice occupational therapy Consent Order in Case 2023-018 are hereby **LIFTED AND TERMINATED** and that those terms and conditions have no further force or effect; and it is further

ORDERED that the Board shall remove the probationary status in its license verification entry for the Respondent's license (Lic. No: A02601); and it is further

ORDERED that this is a Final Decision and Order of the Maryland State Board of Occupational Therapy Practice and as such is a PUBLIC DOCUMENT pursuant to Maryland Code Annotated, General Provisions Article §4-101 et seq.
