**ORDER OF TERMINATION OF PROBATION**


On or about September 21, 2018, the Maryland State Board of Occupational Therapy Practice (the "Board") executed a Final Order of Petition for Reinstatement of Occupational Therapy License, which reinstated the license of Monica Sinha, OTR/L (the "Petitioner"), license number 04896, and placed the Petitioner on probation for a minimum of one (1) year, subject to certain probationary terms and conditions (Case No.2014-004). On or about January 14, 2020, the Petitioner petitioned the Board to terminate the probation upon her license to practice as an occupational therapist. The Board considered the Petition and decided to terminate the probation imposed by the September 21, 2018 Order, based upon the Petitioner's satisfactory compliance with the probationary terms set forth in that Order.

Wherefore, it is hereby:

**ORDERED** that the probation and all associated terms and conditions imposed upon Monica Sinha, OTR/L, license number 04896, as set forth in the September 21, 2018 Final Order of Petition for Reinstatement of Occupational Therapy, is **TERMINATED**, and those terms and conditions are of no further force and effect; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this is a Final Decision and Order of the Maryland State Board of Occupational Therapy Practice and as such is a **PUBLIC DOCUMENT** pursuant to Md. Code Ann., General Provisions §§ 4-101 *et seq.*
