# PRE-CHARGE CONSENT ORDER

### **Background**

On May 31, 2012, the license to practice limited physical therapy held by the Respondent, Jeremy C. Felten, P.T.A. (the "Respondent") expired. On January 9, 2013, the Respondent filed an application for reinstatement with the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners (the "Board") in which he acknowledged that he had provided limited physical therapy services on an expired license.

In lieu of issuing formal Charges against the Respondent for violations of the Maryland Physical Therapy Act, Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 13-101 *et seq.*, the Board voted to resolve this matter by way of a Pre-Charge Consent Order. As a result, the Board and the Respondent have agreed to resolve this matter as set forth in this Consent Order.

## **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. The Respondent was originally licensed in Maryland on August 25, 2008.
- On May 31, 2012, the Respondent's license to practice limited physical therapy in Maryland expired.
- 3. Due to the Respondent's relocation out of state, the Respondent inadvertently failed to renew his license.
- 4. Upon realization of the expiration of his Maryland license, the Respondent immediately contacted the Board for direction and ceased practicing.

- 5. On January 9, 2013, the Respondent filed a reinstatement application with the Board in which he indicated that he provided limited physical therapy services in Maryland during the time his license was expired.
- 6. The Respondent paid the reinstatement fee and provided the appropriate continuing education units required for reinstatement.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Board concludes that the Respondent is in violation of the Maryland Physical Therapy Act, Health Occ. §§13-316(15) and (19) and 13-401.

### **ORDER**

Based on an affirmative vote of the Board, it is this 18th day of January, 2013, hereby:

**ORDERED** that the Respondent pay a fine of \$1,000, payable to the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners within ninety (90) days of the date of this Order; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that the Respondent notify the Respondent's employer of his period of licensure lapse in Maryland, and provide documentation of the Respondent's notification to the Board within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that this is a formal order of the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners and as such is a public document pursuant to the Maryland Annotated Code, State Government Article, Section 10-617(h).
