**ORDER OF MODIFICATION**

The Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners is in receipt of a request from Ricardo Johnson, License No. A3330, requesting modification of the terms of probation as set forth in a Final Decision and Order, dated July 15, 2008. Specifically, the Board's Order placed Mr. Johnson on probation for at least five years, during which time he must: (1) not practice in a home health or long term care setting; (2) successfully complete a board-approved law and ethics course; (3) practice under the direct supervision of a board-approved physical therapist; (4) insure that the board-approved supervisor submits quarterly reports to the Board; and (5) fully comply with the terms of his criminal probation.

Upon consideration of Mr. Ricardo's request, the Board voted to modify the terms of probation as ordered below.

**ORDER**

It is this 16<sup>th</sup> day of November 2010, by an affirmative vote of the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners, hereby,

**ORDERED** that Probationary term #3, requiring Mr. Johnson to practice under the direct supervision of a Board-approved physical therapist, is hereby DELETED. Mr. Johnson may now practice under the general supervision of a physical therapist in accordance with Maryland law; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that Probationary term #4 is hereby MODIFIED to require Mr. Johnson's supervising physical therapist to submit progress reports to the Board every six (6) months; and

be it further,

**ORDERED** that all of the other terms of the July 15, 2008 Final Decision and Order remain in full force and effect; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that this is a modification to a formal order of the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners and as such is a public document pursuant to the Maryland Annotated Code, State Government Article, Section 10-617(h).
