PRE-CHARGE CONSENT ORDER

Background

On May 14, 2009, the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners (the "Board") received an electronic renewal application filed by Joseph J. Nichols. In his application, Mr. Nichols answered "no" to Questions #8 which asks whether a malpractice action has been filed against the applicant. Subsequently, the Board received notice from Medical Mutual regarding a malpractice payment made on behalf of Mr. Nichols.

In lieu of issuing Charges against Mr. Nichols for violation of the Maryland Physical Therapy Act, Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 13-316(1), the Board held a Pre-Charge Case Resolution Conference with Mr. Nichols on April 20, 2010. As a result, the Board and Mr. Nichols have agreed to resolve this matter as set forth in this Consent Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- On May 14, 2009, Mr. Nichols submitted an electronic renewal application to the Board to renew his physical therapist's license, License No. 18065.
- On the renewal application, Question #8 asks, "Has anyone filed or settled a malpractice action in which you were named a defendant?" Mr. Nichols answered "no".
- On July 17, 2009, the Board received a copy of a Medical Malpractice Payment Report from Medical Mutual Liability Insurance indicating that a \$200,000 settlement had been paid out on behalf of Mr. Nichols on June 15, 2009, with no admission of liability.
- 4. As the malpractice claim was filed against Mr. Nichols in or around January 2007, the

Board also reviewed Mr. Nichols' 2007 renewal application. Mr. Nichols also failed to correctly answer Question #8 on his 2007 renewal application.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Board concludes that Mr. Nichols is subject to discipline in accordance with Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 13-316(1).

ORDER

Based on an affirmative vote of the Board, it is this 18 day of May, 2010, hereby:

ORDERED that Mr. Nichols' license to practice physical therapy shall be REPRIMANDED; and be it further,

ORDERED that within sixty (60) days of the date of this Consent Order, Mr. Nichols shall pay a FINE of \$500, payable to the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners; and be it further

ORDERED that this is a formal order of the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners and as such is a public document pursuant to the Maryland Annotated Code, State Government Article, Section 10-617(h).
