**ORDER LIFTING SUSPENSION AND
REINSTATING PHYSICAL THERAPIST LICENSE**

On October 22, 2013, the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners (the “Board”) issued an Order of Suspension of License for Delinquent Child Support (“Order of Suspension”) against Marian Cuba Ruta, Physical Therapist, License No. 18214 (the “Respondent”). The Board suspended the Respondent’s license to practice physical therapy in Maryland due to her delinquent child support payments upon a request from the Montgomery County Office of the Child Support Enforcement Administration of the Maryland Department of Human Resources (the “Administration”), pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Fam. Law § 10-119.3(e)(2)(i) (2012 Repl. Vol.).

On or about October 23, 2013, the Board received a Notice to Reinstate the Respondent’s license from the Administration. Pursuant to the Maryland Physical Therapy Act, Maryland Code Ann., Health Occ. §§ 13-101 *et seq.*, the Respondent otherwise qualifies for a license.

Therefore, pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Fam. Law § 10-119.3(k), on this 23rd day of October, 2013, by the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the suspension of the license to practice physical therapy in Maryland held by Marian Cuba Ruta, License No. 18214, is **LIFTED**; and it is further,

ORDERED that the license to practice physical therapy in Maryland held by Marian Cuba Ruta, License No. 18214, is **REINSTATED** without restrictions or conditions; and it is further,

ORDERED that this is a Final Order of the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners and, as such, is a public document pursuant to Md. Code Ann., State Gov't §§10-617(h).
