## PRE-CHARGE CONSENT ORDER

#### **Background**

On May 1, 2013, Tessa Winn completed an online renewal application for her license to practice limited physical therapy in Maryland, License No. A3277. On the same day, Ms. Winn contacted the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners (the "Board") to disclose that she did not complete the required twenty (20) continuing education contact hours by the deadline of March 31, 2013, and that she changed the completion date for half of the continuing education contact hours on her renewal application from May 1, 2013, to March 31, 2013, in order to complete the online renewal process.

In lieu of instituting formal proceedings against Ms. Winn for violations of the Maryland Physical Therapy Act, Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 13-101 *et seq.*, the Board voted to resolve this matter by way of a Pre-Charge Consent Order. As a result, the Board and Ms. Winn have agreed to resolve this matter as set forth in this Consent Order.

### FINDINGS OF FACT

 At all times relevant hereto, Ms. Winn was licensed to practice limited physical therapy in Maryland, License No. A3277. Ms. Winn was first licensed by the Board on May 14, 2008, and her license is set to expire on May 31, 2013.

- 2. On May 1, 2013, Ms. Winn completed an application for the renewal of her license online. On her online renewal application, Ms. Winn stated that she completed a total of twenty-four (24) continuing education contact hours, including twelve (12) hours she completed on March 31, 2013.
- 3. On the same day, Ms. Winn sent an email to the Board disclosing that the twelve (12) contact hours that she stated on her application were completed on March 31, 2013, were actually completed on May 1, 2013. Ms. Winn stated that she changed the completion date because the online system would not let her complete a renewal application with a continuing education completion date later than March 31, 2013.
- 4. Ms. Winn also stated that she did not realize at the time that the deadline for her to complete her continuing education contact hours, in accordance with Board regulations (COMAR 10.28.08.05), was March 31, 2013.

# **CONCLUSION OF LAW**

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Board concludes that Ms. Winn is subject to disciplinary action in accordance with Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 13-316(15) and COMAR 10.38.08.05.

### **ORDER**

**ORDERED** that Ms. Winn shall pay a fine in the amount of \$400, payable to the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners, within ninety (90) days of the date of the Order; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that failure to pay in full the above fine within ninety (90) days of the date of this Order shall be considered a violation of this Order, and after notice and opportunity for a show cause hearing shall subject Ms. Winn to further discipline such as suspension, revocation, or further fines based on the violations cited in this Order; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that this is a formal order of the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners and as such is a public document pursuant to the Maryland Annotated Code, State Government Article, Section 10-617(h).
