ORDER OF TERMINATION OF PROBATION

On January 13, 2023 the Maryland Board of Social Work Examiners (the "Board") entered into a Consent Order (the "Consent Order") with licensee Foster H. Joseph (the "Respondent").

The Consent Order suspended the Respondent's license to practice social work for a period of **SIX (6) months** and stayed the suspension. The Consent Order also placed the Respondent's license on probation for **TWO (2) years**.

While on probation, the Respondent was required to adhere to terms and conditions of probation outlined in the Consent Order.

Pursuant to the Consent Order the Respondent was entitled to petition the Board to terminate the probation after two years.

On May 9, 2025 the Board considered the Respondent's petition to terminate the probation outlined in the Consent Order.

Based on the Respondent's compliance with the Probation in the Order and upon consideration by the Board it is hereby:

**ORDERED** that the probationary terms and conditions imposed upon the license of Foster H. Joseph (Lic. No.: G-11025) to practice social work by the Consent Order in Case 19-

2686 are hereby **LIFTED AND TERMINATED** and that those terms and conditions have no further force or effect; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the Board shall remove the probationary status in its license verification entry for the Respondent's license (Lic. No: G-11025); and it is further

**ORDERED** that this is a Final Decision and Order of the Maryland State Board of Social Work Examiners and as such is a **PUBLIC DOCUMENT** pursuant to Maryland Code Annotated, General Provisions Article §4-101 *et seq.*
