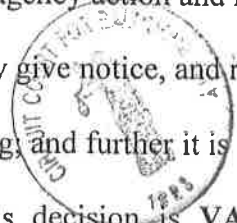
ORDER

This matter came before the court on February 11, 2019, on Petitioner Yvette Phillips's Petition for Judicial Review (Doc. No. 1). Having considered Petitioner's Rule 7-207 Memorandum (Doc. No. 7) and Respondent's Answering Memorandum (Doc. No. 7/1), as well as the administrative record of this matter, and following oral argument by counsel, for the reasons set forth on the record in open court, it is this 11th day of February, 2019:

FOUND that Respondent made an error of law by failing to take the required and/or reasonable steps to notify Petitioner of the agency action and hearing, holding a hearing in Petitioner's absence after failing to properly give notice, and revoking Petitioner's license without reasonable opportunity for a hearing, and further it is

ORDERED that the Respondent's decision is **VACATED**, and that the matter is **REMANDED** for a proper evidentiary hearing before Respondent.
