CONSENT ORDER

The Maryland Board of Social Work Examiners (the "Board") charged Jaime M. Sullivan, License Master Social Worker (LMSW), (the "Respondent"), License Number 20181, with violating various provisions of the Maryland Social Workers Act (the "Act"), codified at Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. §§ 19-101 et seq. (2014 Repl. Vol. and 2020 Supp.).

The pertinent provisions of the Act provide the following:

§ 19-311. Grounds for license denials, discipline

Subject to the hearing provisions of § 19-312 of this subtitle, the Board may deny a license to any applicant, fine a licensee, reprimand any licensee, place any licensee on probation, or suspend or revoke a license if the applicant of licensee:

- (4) Commits any act of gross negligence, incompetence, or misconduct in the practice of social work;
- (5) Engages in a course of conduct that is inconsistent with generally accepted professional standards in the practice of social work; [and]

(6) Violates any provision of this title or regulations governing the practice of social work adopted and published by the Board[.]

COMAR 10.42.06.03 – Continuing Education Requirements

- A. The Board shall renew a license for an additional 2-year period if the social worker:
 - (1) Completes 40 (30 for Licensed Bachelor Social Workers) continuing education units within the renewal period, of which a minimum of:
 - a. 20 (15 for Licensed Bachelor Social Workers) continuing education units shall be obtained from approved programs which are Category I;
 - b. 3 of the required Category I or Category II continuing education units shall have a content area focusing on ethics and professional conduct, including boundary issues, or pertaining to the standards of practice and laws governing the profession of social work in Maryland;

...

- (2) Submits an application as set forth in COMAR 10.42.01 attesting to completion of the required continuing education units in approved programs; and
- (3) Completes the required continuing education units within a 2-year period as set forth in §B of this regulation.

B. Time Frame.

- (1) Renewed licenses are valid for a 2-year period from November 1 through and including October 31, during which time continuing education units may be earned.
- (2) Continuing education units obtained in one renewal period may not be carried over to the next renewal period.

COMAR 10.42.06.07 – Consequences of Failure to Comply with Continuing Education Requirements.

The Board shall notify a social worker by first class mail that the license has not been renewed if the following has occurred:

D. The social worker has not responded to audit requirements within the time required.

COMAR 10.42.06.02 - Definitions.

- (4) "Category I" means activities that are formally organized face-to-face learning experiences provided by Board-approved sponsors.
- (5) "Category II" means activities that are independent, less structured learning experiences.
- (7) "Continuing education" means completing approved programs designed to provide:
 - (a) Enhancement of social work practice, values, skills, and knowledge; and
 - (b) Enrichment of social work services and competence.
- (8) "Continuing education unit" means 1 hour (60 minutes) of an approved program as set forth in Regulation .04 of this chapter.
- (12) "Renewal period" means the period from the date the license was issued or November 1 of the renewal year to October 31 of the expiration year.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Board finds that:

- 1. The Respondent was initially licensed to practice as a Licensed Master Social Worker ("LMSW") by the Board on July 30, 2014. Her license expired on October 31, 2020.
- 2. On or about November 1, 2018, the Respondent renewed her LMSW license for the period of November 1, 2018 through October 31, 2020.
- 3. On or about January 9, 2019, the Association of Social Work Boards ("ASWB") mailed a letter to the Respondent on behalf of the Board notifying her that she had been randomly selected for inclusion in a Post-Renewal Continuing Education Audit and requesting that she submit copies of all training certificates to the Board by February 11, 2019. The Board did not receive a response.
- 4. On or about February 11, 2019, a second post-renewal audit notice was sent to the Respondent requesting that the outstanding documents be provided within 15 business days. The Board did not receive a response.
- 5. On or about March 6, 2019, the Board sent a third notice to the Respondent.

 The requested materials were not received by the Board.
- 6. On or about April 13, 2020, the Board sent a final notice to the Respondent via regular and certified mail requesting that all outstanding documents be provided within 15 business days. No response was received by the Board.
- 7. The Board's audit revealed that the Board never received continuing education unit documentation from the Respondent. The Respondent held

an active license during the time period of this audit and did not meet the Board's continuing education requirement.

8. On or about July 27, 2020, a pre-charge Consent Order was sent to the Respondent, but no reply was received by the Board.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Board concludes as a matter of law that the Respondent violated:

- C. The Board shall renew a license for an additional 2-year period if the social worker:
 - (4) Completes 40 (30 for Licensed Bachelor Social Workers) continuing education units within the renewal period, of which a minimum of:
 - a. 20 (15 for Licensed Bachelor Social Workers) continuing education units shall be obtained from approved programs which are Category I;

D. Time Frame.

- (3) Renewed licenses are valid for a 2-year period from November 1 through and including October 31, during which time continuing education units may be earned.
- (4) Continuing education units obtained in one renewal period may not be carried over to the next renewal period.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, it is this day of November, 2021, by a majority of the quorum of the Board considering this case hereby:

ORDERED that the Respondent shall be **REPRIMANDED**; and it is further

ORDERED that upon renewal or reinstatement, the Respondent's license to practice social work shall be placed on PROBATION for a minimum of ONE (1) YEAR, and continuing until the Respondent has successfully completed the following probationary conditions:

- The Respondent shall complete the 40.0 outstanding Category I and Category II CEUs which include 3.0 Category I or Category II ethics within 180 days.
- iv. The Respondent shall comply with the Maryland Social Workers Act and all laws, statutes and regulations pertaining thereof.

ORDERED that the Respondent shall pay a monetary fine of ONE-THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1500) within one year.

ORDERED that upon any renewal or reinstatement of the Respondent's license to

practice social work in the State of Maryland, she shall be automatically audited for two

licensing renewal cycles.

ORDERED that If the Respondent violates any of the terms and conditions of this

Consent Order, the Board, in its discretion, after notice and an opportunity for an

evidentiary hearing if there is a genuine dispute as to the underlying facts, or an

opportunity for a show cause hearing before the Board otherwise, may impose any

sanction that the Board may have imposed in this case, including additional probationary

terms and conditions, a reprimand, suspension, revocation and/or a monetary penalty;

ORDERED that the Respondent shall be responsible for all costs incurred in

fulfilling the terms and conditions of this Consent Order; and

ORDERED that the Consent Order is a **PUBLIC DOCUMENT** pursuant to Md.

Code Ann., Gen. Prov. §§ 4-101 et seq. (2014 Repl. Vol. and 2020 Supp.).
