ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On January 24, 2022 the Maryland Board of Social Work Examiners (the "Board") entered into a pre-charge Consent Order (the "Consent Order") with Jonathan Williams (the "Respondent").

Pursuant to the Consent Order the Board issued the Respondent a license to practice as an LMSW in the State of Maryland and immediately placed the Respondent on probation for a minimum period of two (2) years. The Respondent subsequently filed a timely petition to terminate the probation.

On March 13, 2026 the Board met in its quasi-judicial capacity to review the Respondent's timely petition to terminate the probation.

After reviewing the Respondent's petition and in recognition of the Respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions of probation in case 2020-2785, the Board will grant the Respondent's request. Therefore it is hereby:

ORDERED that the probation imposed upon the license of Jonathan Williams, to practice social work pursuant to the Consent Order in Case 2020-2785, is hereby **LIFTED AND TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a Final Decision and Order of the Maryland State Board of Social Work Examiners and as such is a PUBLIC DOCUMENT pursuant to Maryland Code Annotated, General Provisions Article §4-101 et seq.
