

2025-2027 REGISTRATION RENEWAL NOTICE & REMINDER

CHIROPRACTIC ASSISTANTS

2025 Registration Expiration Date: **March 31, 2025.** Monitor the website for updates.

Registration Renewal, Initial Inactive Status Election and Renewal of Inactive Status: Are to be completed using the online renewal portal.

Online Renewal Portal Opens February 6, 2025 at 6 p.m. Access is through the Board's website at www.health.maryland.gov/chiropractic. A 'Renewal Resource Page' will be posted on the Board's website in mid-January 2025, listing all renewal information.

Mandatory CEUs, Implicit Bias Training & CPR Certification: CAs are required to complete 10 hours of CEUs, **Implicit Bias** training, and possess an unexpired CPR certificate-Provider Level at the time of renewal. The CEU must have been completed between April 1, 2023 and the date of registration renewal.

CEUs Exemption Notice: Initial registrations issued on or after April 1, 2024 with an expiration date of March 31, 2025 are exempt from the CEU requirements. However, the CA must renew the registration, must possess a valid CPR certification at the Provider Level, and complete the Implicit Bias training.

Renewal Fees between February 7, 2025 and March 31, 2025: **Renewal—\$250.00** **Inactive Status—\$50.00**
Late Renewal Fees between April 1, 2025 – April 30, 2025: **Renewal—\$450.00** **Inactive Status—\$250.00**

Tax Leins and/or Child Support Holds must be resolved with either the MD Comptroller and/or The Division of Child Support Enforcement. The Board must be officially notified by those agencies of the clearance before a registration may be renewed and issued.

Address Change: Complete and submit the Notification of Address Change form **immediately** if your address has changed since your last renewal or issuance of your registration.
