IMPLICIT BIAS TRAINING

New License and Registration Renewal Requirements for Chiropractors and Chiropractic Assistants

Senate Bill 5 and House Bill 28, passed by the Maryland General Assembly in 2021, requires all applicants for renewal of licenses or registrations for health occupations to complete an Implicit Bias Training Program approved by the Cultural and Linguistic Health Care Professional Competency Program within the Maryland Department of Health. This requirement becomes effective as of April 1, 2022, and affects all licensees and registrants who renew their license/registration starting in 2022. **This requirement applies only to the first renewal cycle after April 1, 2022.**

Although not considered to be continuing education, the Board has approved continuing education credit hour(s) for completion of the program.

Course Availability

The Cultural and Linguistic Health Care Professional Competency Program within the Maryland Department of Health must approve the implicit bias training program. **Other courses are not approved and will not be accepted.** The list of approved courses may be accessed at <https://health.maryland.gov/mhhd/Pages/Implicit-Bias-Resources.aspx>.
