C. Inquiry from AACC regarding establishment of CA training curriculum. **Motion** to consider CA curriculum should one be established by the community college and presented to the Board. – **Passed**.

D. Inquiry from DC regarding proper office sign-in procedure for minor patient. Per Board Counsel, the Board does not dictate patient sign-in procedures to licensees. Issue with treatment of minors is most often regarding informed consent and licensees should refer to applicable regulations.
