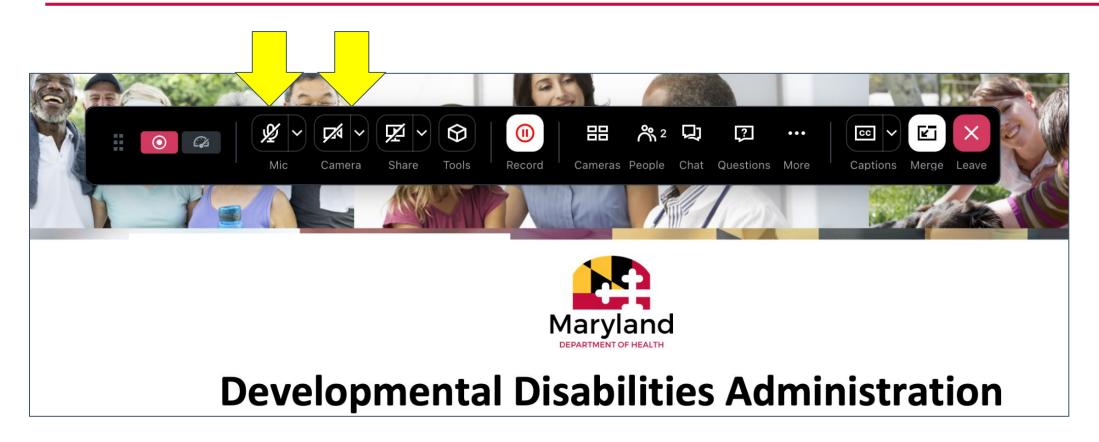

- The 988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline is a support helpline for people experiencing mental health or substance use emergencies. People can call (or text or chat) 9-8-8 to talk and to connect with services.
- Maryland Mobile Crisis is a group of behavioral health teams across the state.
 - Licensed mobile crisis providers in 14 jurisdictions

- Hands-on training for and by people with disabilities that is designed to provide the tools to be a good self advocate, connect with others in advocacy and gain leadership skills and experience.

DDA FY 2026 Budget Overview (1 of 3)

Governor's DDA Budget

- Historic investment of \$1.3 Billion in State General Funds, equalling \$2.6 billion in combined State and federal funds. More than two-thirds more funding than in FY 2023.
- This investment will support:
 - Continued enrollment of new individuals into service (Transitioning Youth, individuals in crisis situations, and others).
 - Moderate rate increases for all services.
 - Continued investment in the LTSSMaryland system, reducing provider administrative burden and increasing performance for essential eligibility and access processes.




