Family Supports, Community Supports, and Community Pathways Waivers Self Directed Services - VENDOR Reasonable and Customary Rates - Effective July 1, 2023

Overview: Participants self-directing services can hire vendors for approved services in their Person-Centered Plan. Vendors must meet service qualifications. Participants establish payment rates for vendors. Vendor rates must be reasonable and customary. The following table provides information on rate ranges to consider.

Guidance:

- 1. Participants are responsible for the vendor costs. These costs come out of the participant's budget.
- 2. Participants can negotiate lower rates with vendors.
- 3. Vendors are considered self-employed. Vendors are responsible for their own taxes and business-related expenses. Participants do not pay for vendor taxes and other related business expenses. Vendors are paid a flat fee or rate.
- 4. Participants can hire DDA providers (See Provider Reasonable and Customary Rates).
- 5. Participants can increase the rate they pay vendors.
- 6. Participants are not required to increase the vendor rates.
- 7. Rate increases can be based on performance.
- 8. Rate increases can be offered at any time during the year.
- 9. A higher rate can be used for the following counties Calvert, Charles, Frederick, Montgomery, or Prince George's.
- 10. Personal Supports Enhanced and Community Development Services 2:1 and 1:1 staff supports are based on documented need in the Person-Centered Plan

Note: This plan language document is an overview of information and requirements. The requirements set forth in this document are not exhaustive. Detailed requirements can be reviewed in the DDA operated Medicaid Waiver Program applications, applicable laws, regulations, guidance, and policies.
