To help people with developmental disabilities find their own home in communities of their choosing.

What are Housing Support Services?

- Housing Support Services include a housing support specialist who will:
 - Support you in creating a housing support plan
 - Support you with applying for rental assistance programs
 - Support you with applying for new apartments or homes
 - o Support you in learning how to be a responsible renter
 - o Support you in learning how to budget your money and pay bills
 - o Advocate with you

How do I access Housing Support Services?

• If you want to live in your own home in a community of your choosing, let your Coordinator of Community Services (CCS) know they can help you find a housing support specialist.

If I live in my own home in the community, can I still access other DDA services?

 Yes, as long as you are DD and waiver eligible you can continue to access other DDA services such as Supported Living, Personal Supports, Meaningful Day Services, Technology, Environmental Modifications, etc.
