Employment Services Update

Employment First Workgroup

- Goal of Employment 1st Workgroup:
 - To increase Competitive Integrated Employment for DDA participants
- Next Steps:
 - Going to reset and regroup to ensure more efficient use of time and resources to ensure successful completion of objectives
 - Draft new charter for group as a whole vs. subcommittees
 - Review membership - ensuring cross-representation

Acuity Feedback

Acuity Feedback Survey

- Providers were asked to submit detailed guidance on acuity to identify potential analyses to include:
 - Specific services to address
 - Specific adjustments to the rate methodology
 - Data required and data collection timing
- Feedback survey and reminders shared with approximately 350 providers on 3/7, 3/11, & 3/19
- 31 Total Respondents
 - 21 respondents indicated they wanted to suggest an approach for an acuity adjustment
 - 18 of those responses were directly related to acuity

Acuity Feedback Survey Responses

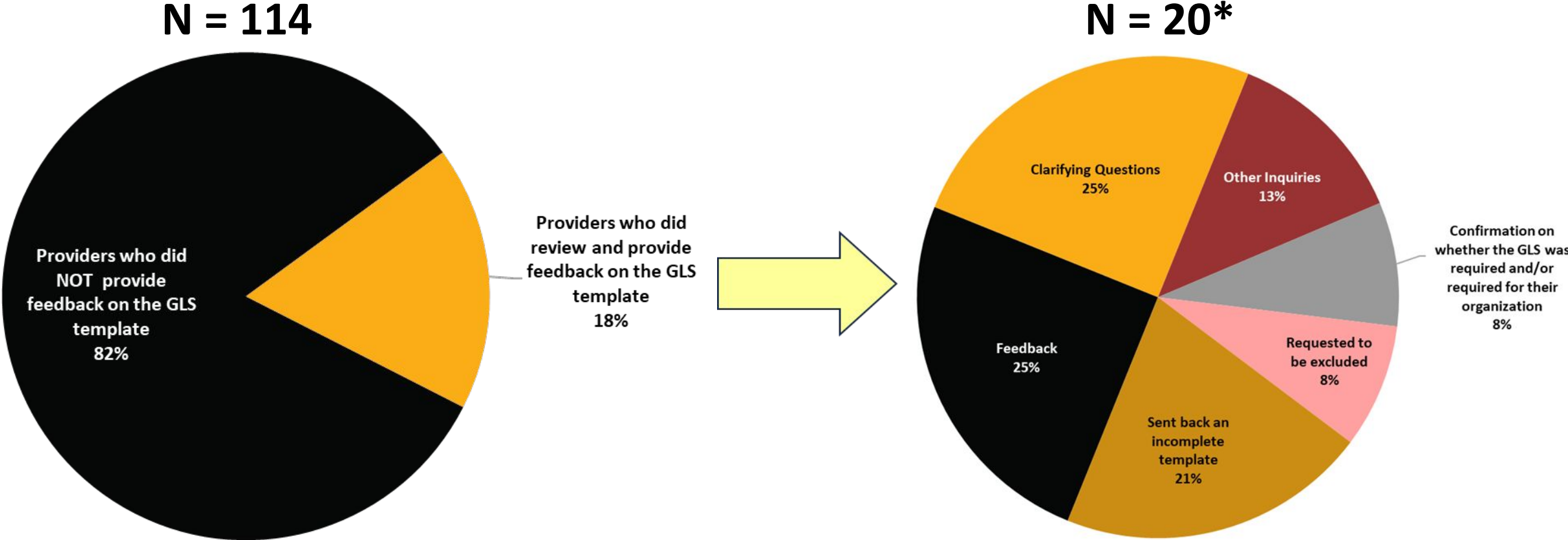
Provider Acuity Feedback Themes	Current DDA Services and Policies
Identifying individuals with higher needs	DDA uses the following processes to identify individuals with higher needs: person-centered planning tools; the Health Risk Screening Tool (HRST); and other health and welfare assessments, to determine the participant’s assessed needs, level of services, and preferences
All residential, meaningful day, and respite services should be considered	The DDA-operated Medicaid waiver programs include enhanced residential, meaningful day, and supports services, overnight supports and overnight supervision, dedicated supports including 1:1 and 2:1 staff-to-participant supports, and enhanced rates.
Data elements: matrix scores, HRST scores, # of behavioral plans, and # of nursing plans	Behavioral Support Plan or Nursing Care Plan

Acuity: Next Steps

- Acuity analyses will not be completed for the FY 26 rate cycle
- **Acuity Lunch and Learn Sessions** to highlight current strategies and range of services will be available for providers and CCS agencies
 - Opportunities for peer-to-peer learning
 - Specific examples and strategies

GLS Data Collection

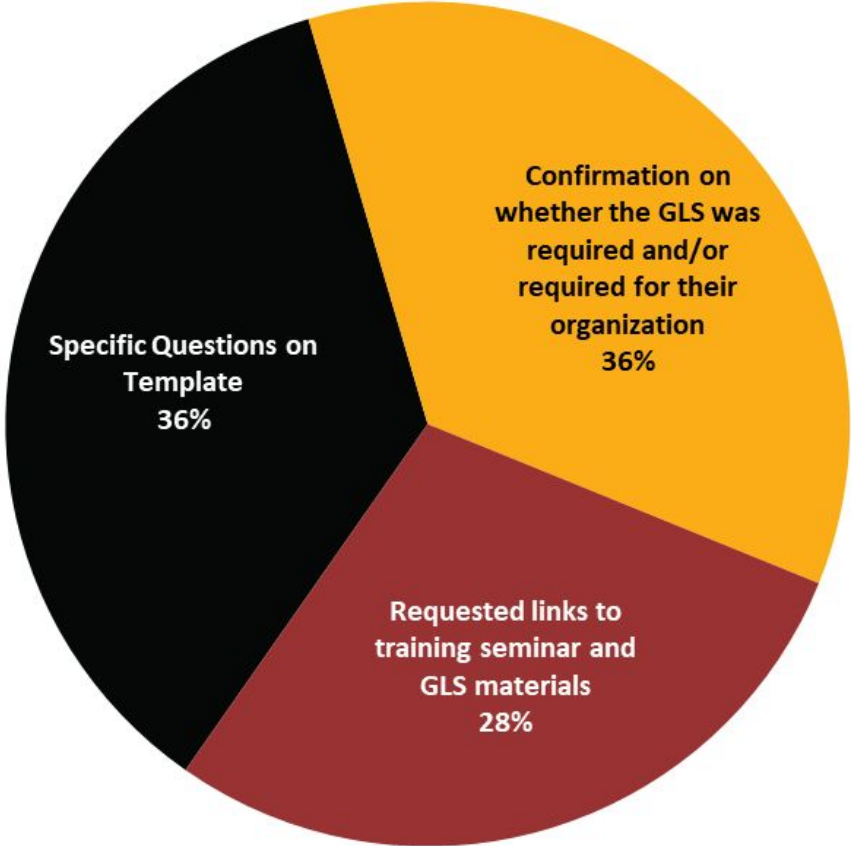
- The finalized GLS template and instructions were shared with day habilitation providers on 3/19/24 and posted to the [DDA RRAG Website](#)

 - Templates received, representation of providers, and representation of individuals served

GLS: TA Sessions

- TA sessions were well attended, recorded and posted to the [RRAG website](#)
 - 3/21/24: 82 attendees
 - 4/1/24: 87 attendees
 - Total number of unduplicated attendees: 156
- Key themes for questions:
 - Confirmation on what providers are required to submit data
 - DSP staff and wages information
 - Clarification on specific items and cost categories
 - How to report no non-billable time
- Hilltop has received over a dozen emails from providers with questions and/or requesting clarification


