

We Take Precautions for You

Your Safety Is Our Priority

Because our patients are important to us, this dental office follows Universal Precautions to protect your health at every visit.

What This Means for You

Hand Hygiene

We wash our hands before and after patient care using soap and water or an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.

Gloves

We wear gloves whenever providing care inside your mouth. Gloves are changed between every patient.

Safe Disposal of Needles and Sharps

Used needles and sharp instruments are placed in puncture-proof containers.

Protective Equipment

Masks, eye protection, and gowns are worn to protect both patients and staff from splashes or sprays of blood and body fluids.

Sterilized Dental Instruments

All dental instruments — including handpieces (dental drills) — are cleaned, disinfected, and heat-sterilized using FDA-approved equipment.

Clean and Disinfected Surfaces

Treatment rooms and equipment are cleaned and disinfected according to infection control guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).
