

Child Support License Suspension Program

By law, the Maryland State Board of Dental Examiners ("Board") cannot issue a new license to an applicant who is under a court order to pay child support and is past due arrears amounting to more than 120 days. Furthermore, the Board is obligated to suspend your active license if notified by the Department of Social Services ("DSS") that you are in arrears with child support payments. During the suspension, you cannot practice dentistry. Also, if your license is suspended the suspension will be public information. Once a payment plan has been worked out by you and DSS, and the Board receives confirmation, your license will be reinstated.
