# Why do I need to submit to the SDI?

As established by the MDH Data Use Policy issued in December 2021, any agreement entered into by a MDH unit that involves the use or access of MDH data requires SDI Review. In other words, if data is being shared outside of MDH pursuant to a contract or other agreement, that contract or other agreement must be reviewed by the SDI Team. This includes data-related agreements that are required by law, statute, or grant. In the case of required agreements, the SDI Team serves in an advisory capacity and provides non-binding recommendations.

### When do I need to submit to the SDI?

MDH units should submit data-related agreements to the SDI Team **prior to execution** when they are doing one of the following:

- 1. Entering a new agreement
- 2. Renewing an existing agreement
- 3. Revising or amending an existing agreement

# What is the SDI Team looking for?

The SDI Team reviews data-related agreements for three key measures:

- Is the data on an approved system?
- Are the appropriate IT safeguards and access controls in place?
- Does the agreement comply with privacy laws?

Based on these criteria, the SDI Team will analyze the data-related agreements and make recommendations for how to best secure the MDH data involved.

#### **SDI REVIEW TIMELINE**

The SDI Team will have 30 days from the date of submission to review the data-related agreement and request any additional information needed for the review. This may include requiring vendors to complete the Security Controls and Data Survey, submit proof of a SOC 2 Type II audit, or answer questions regarding data migration into an approved system.
