# Inside DHMH Building Security

- Uniformed Officer at the Main Security Desk Entrance 24/7
- Security post at loading dock.
- Screen all visitors per protocol standards and verify identity/destination.
- Multiple safety zones/rings (turn-styles, card access, keys, etc.)
- Monitor the CCTV for activity inside and outside the premises.
- Maintain active radio communications with outside security personnel.
- Conduct CCTV or Video Escorts to and from the site.

## Department of Public Safety

EBDI's Department of Public Safety is committed to the well-being of its residents, visitors and business community within the entire 88-acre, master-planned community.

EBDI, along with Forest City and Johns Hopkins Hospital has contracted with Broadway Services – Silver Star Security, a 25-year-old company based in the community, for 24/7 security within the EBDI neighborhood. This ensures that the community is saturated by a single, uniformed security provider, bringing maximum coverage, coordination and effective deployment.

The Environmental Services Team is on the job through the workweek to maintain the community to a high standard. Sidewalks are swept, and heavily trafficked commercial streets and areas within the project receive daily cleaning. Additionally, the team maintains public green space and provides sidewalk snow removal.

Other essential services provided are safety awareness programs and youth engagement activities in conjunction with city and private partners.

# New Construction/Development

- Have implemented new streetscape and security “guidelines” that enhances safety:
  - Improved street lighting – more uniform lighting and higher light levels along sidewalks
  - Selected landscaping that minimizes “hiding” places
  - Consistent security measures across new development
  - Security is tied in/shared amongst all buildings to improve coordination and response time
- Eliminating/Demolishing/boarding up vacant buildings
