**CERTIFICATION OF HAZMAT INSPECTION**

To protect our employees from unknown hazardous components (i.e., explosives, radiation, chemicals) which may be contained in unopened packages and letters, the Laboratories Administration requires that the submitting organization certify that submitted unopened samples have undergone basic field safety screening to rule out the presence of explosives, radiation, flammability, corrosives, and volatile organic compounds prior to delivery to the Laboratories Administration.
