#### IMPORTANT NOTICE: LICENSE/REGISTRATION RENEWAL REQUIRED

June 20, 2024

Dear Licensees and Registrants:

The 2024-2026 license and registrant renewal cycle is fast approaching. The Massage Board takes this opportunity to remind you of the requirement to renew your license or registration to lawfully practice massage therapy in Maryland for the next two years. Below is information on key dates, required renewal fees, and CEU renewal requirements for the 2024-2026 licensure/registration period.

**License/Registration Expiration Date: October 31, 2024.**

**Renewal Deadline:** On or before October 31, 2024. New Inactive status changes and status continuations may also be completed online during the renewal period. **All licenses and registrations must be renewed regardless of the original issue date.**

**Online Renewal Access Starts on or about August 12, 2024:** through the Board's website at [www.health.maryland.gov/massage](http://www.health.maryland.gov/massage).

**Fees:**

- **Renewal Fee Charged August 2024-October 31, 2024:** LMT: \$276 RMP: \$250
- **Late Renewal Fee Charged November 1, 2024 -November 30, 2024:** LMT: \$476 RMP: \$450
- **Reinstatement Fee Charges after November 30, 2024:** LMT: \$501 RMP: \$475
- **Inactive Status Fee:** \$50
- **Late Inactive Status Fee:** \$250

**Continuing Education Requirements: Mandatory CEUs, Electives, Mandatory Implicit Bias Training, and CPR Certification:**

- 7 Hrs. Mandatory CEUs: 3 Hrs. Ethics or Jurisprudence, 3 Hrs. in Communicable Diseases including HIV/AIDS, and 1 Hr. Diversity or Cultural Competency.
- 17 Hrs. Elective CEUs in Massage Therapy.

- 1 Hr. Implicit Bias training if this is your first renewal after initial licensure/registration.
- CPR Certification: Must possess an unexpired CPR certificate (LMTs Healthcare Provider Level & RMP's Basic CPR) at the time of renewal.

CEUs are to be completed between 11/01/2022 and the date you complete your online renewal.

**CEU Exemption Notice-Initial license or registration issued after October 31, 2023:** Initial licenses and registrations issued after 10/31/2023 are exempt from the CEU requirements but must be renewed online. The licensee or registrant must hold a valid CPR certification and complete the implicit bias training.

**CEU Exemption, Waiver, or Extension of Time to Complete:** Pursuant to COMAR 10.65.05.03B, a licensee or registrant with documented hardships may seek an exemption, a waiver, or an extension of time to complete the continuing education requirements. The petition must be in writing and received by the Board **no later than July 15, 2024**. The petition form is attached.

**LMTs & RMPs with Tax Leins and/or Child Support Holds:** The Board must receive official clearance from the MD Comptroller and/or the Division of Child Support Enforcement before a license or registration may be issued.
