Dialysis Technician for Out-of-State Endorsement Applicants

- Endorsement applicants must have attended a dialysis technician training program that meets the standards of an approved dialysis technician program in Maryland to be eligible for the Dialysis Technician certification.
- To be considered for endorsement to Maryland, the applicant must have a DT certificate that is current, active, and in good standing in the state of issuance, and the state in which the applicant is certified must have certification requirements that are essentially similar to those in Maryland.
- If you do not have an active, current out-of-state DT certificate in good standing, you must complete a Maryland Board approved Dialysis Technician training program to be eligible for Maryland certification as a DT.

Tips to Avoid Delays in Obtaining Certification

The following are common omissions in completing the application, that cause a delay in obtaining certification:

- The applicant has failed to include a copy of the out-of-state DT certification.
- Applicant fails to provide the documentation required if the applicant answers “yes” in response to any of the disciplinary questions. If you answer “yes” to any discipline question, please provide the information listed on the application.
- The applicant fails to provide proof of fingerprinting.
