This was the third year the bills regarding Health Occupations – Licensed Direct-Entry Midwives – Previous Cesarean Section were presented to the Maryland General Assembly, and although progress was made, HB351 passed unanimously with support and was approved, the SB376 was referred to the Finance Committee. Ms. Gordon reported that Melanie Griffith was unable to speak to Mr. Ellis, Sponsor of SB376. The Committee discussed the need for an "Instructions Sheet" (cover page) with information and guidance to the Licensed Direct-Entry Midwife ("LDEM") completing the renewal application, including the date the renewal applications must be received to the Board, to allow time for the Committee to review each renewal application to be sure it is complete, before each renewal application is presented to the Board for approval to renew each LDEM license.  Each LDEM renewal applicant is required to submit documentation for 20 Board-approved Continuing Education Units (CEUs). Regarding the peer review requirement, the Committee discussed the need to require the LDEM renewal applicant to provide a copy of the LDEM's current North American Registry of Midwives ("NARM") certification as evidence of completion of this requirement.
