**ORDER OF DENIAL OF REINSTATEMENT OF  
MEDICATION TECHNICIAN CERTIFICATE**

**I. PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND**

On April 14, 2015, the Maryland Board of Nursing (the “Board”) issued a “Default Final Decision and Order of Revocation” (the “Revocation Order”), which revoked the certificate of **Anthony Mitchell** (the “Respondent”) to practice as a medication technician (“MT”) in the State of Maryland (certificate number MT0063617). The Revocation Order was based on the Respondent’s termination from his employer for unethical conduct while on duty.

**II. CONSIDERATION OF REINSTATEMENT REQUEST**

On or about October 30, 2021, the Respondent submitted a written request to the Board seeking reinstatement of his certificate to practice as an MT in the State of Maryland. In support of his reinstatement request, the Respondent provided a letter requesting reinstatement, evidence of medication technician course completion, and evidence of completion of continuing education courses.

The Board has reviewed and considered the documentation that the Respondent submitted in support of his application for reinstatement of his MT certificate, as well as all additional documentation in the Respondent’s file. Upon consideration thereof, the Board finds that the Respondent has not met his burden of showing that he is a suitable candidate for reinstatement of his MT certificate at this time. Accordingly, the Board denies the Respondent’s reinstatement request.
