ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT AND PROBATION

WHEREAS, the Maryland State Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners (the “Board”) accepted a Surrender of License, on September 26, 2018, of Howard Schultheiss, D.P.M., License Number 01108, to practice podiatric medicine in the State of Maryland;

WHEREAS, on December 28, 2018, the Board having received a petition for reinstatement, the Board hereby approves Dr. Schultheiss’ request for reinstatement pursuant to the Health Occupations Article (“HO”) section 16-316. It is therefore:

ORDERED, that Dr. Schultheiss’ license shall be **REINSTATED**; and it is

ORDERED that Dr. Schultheiss shall be placed on **PROBATION** for a period of **one (1) year**, effective from the date of this Order of Reinstatement and Probation; and it is

ORDERED that Dr. Schultheiss shall comply with the specific terms and conditions of the Amended Consent Order of Probation; and it is


ORDERED, that if Dr. Schultheiss fails to comply with the terms and conditions of the Amended Consent Order of Probation, the Board may, after notice of the alleged noncompliance and a hearing, impose any disciplinary sanction it deems appropriate under HO § 16-311; and it is


ORDERED, that at the end of the one-year probationary period, Dr. Schultheiss shall petition the Board for the termination of probation and full reinstatement of his Maryland podiatric medicine license, provided that, at that time, Dr. Schultheiss is not under investigation, or no charges have been issued against him; and it is

ORDERED, that Dr. Schultheiss shall not petition the Board for an early termination of probation; and it is further

ORDERED, that this a Final Order of the Maryland State Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners and as such is a **PUBLIC RECORD** pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Gen. Prov. §§ 4-101 *et seq.*
