

2023 Legislative Session (last year)

SB 556/ Chapter 644 – Maryland Community Health Resources Commission – Compensation of Employees and Funding.

The bill authorized the CHRC to set the salaries for certain CHRC positions.

Maintained the CHRC \$8 million in special funds and identified a new source of special funds — Cigarette Restitution Fund.

2024 Legislative Session (this year)

Fiscal 2024 allowance \$108 million.

Fiscal 2025 allowance \$ 133 million.

No recommended cuts in the Governor's Budget.
