### **Overview of FY 2024 Request for Applications**

- Approximately \$7 million available for new grant funding
- CHRC staff recommends the strategic priorities and areas of focus remain similar to the FY 2023 Call for Proposals.
- Strategic Priority 1: Advance health equity by addressing health disparities and adverse social determinants of health... supporting place-based initiatives aligned with the Advancing All-Payer Health Equity Approaches and Development (AHEAD) model.
- Strategic Priority 2: Promote the efficient and strategic delivery of integrated health and social services... and promote genuine community engagement.
