
## Baltimore County Public Schools Priorities Maryland Consortium on Consolidated Community Supports September 2023



Parties interested in receiving funding for services provided to Baltimore County Public Schools stakeholders from the Maryland Community Health Resources Commission (MCHRC)'s Request for Proposals under the Maryland Consortium on Consolidated Community Supports (Consortium) are required to receive a letter of support from Baltimore County Public Schools.

Requests for letters of support should be submitted at this <u>link</u> by Friday, September 22. Responses to the request will be sent by Wednesday, October 4.

Baltimore County Public Schools has identified the following priority needs that support its Blueprint for Maryland's Future and will consider supporting proposals that address the established needs:

- Evidence-Based Programs/Practices (EBPs) that provide or enhance social-emotional learning in after-school/weekend programs, particularly those that target rniddle-schoolaged youth.
- Mentoring or other EBPs for at-risk youth.
- Training for school staff on EBPs.
- Expanded access to behavioral health counseling, including telehealth. Note, providers of
  telehealth services must undergo BCPS fingerprinting and background checks, and the
  sponsoring agency must provide a staff member at the school to supervise telehealth
  encounters that occur dming the school day.
- Expanded access to behavioral health counseling for uninsured and under-insured children and youth, including support for prescriptions.
