

## MARYLAND CONSORTIUM ON COORDINATED COMMUNITY SUPPORTS

The Maryland Consortium on Coordinated Community Supports is an entity responsible for developing a statewide framework to expand access to comprehensive behavior health services for Maryland students. The Consortium was created by the General Assembly as part of the Blueprint for Maryland's Future.

The Consortium has developed recommendations for a Call for Proposals (RFP) that can be found on their <u>website</u>. Grant funding will be provided for both fiscal year 2023 and fiscal year 2024. The RFP is posted on the CHRC's <u>website</u>.

To be considered for these grant funds with the Consortium, agencies must receive a letter of support from Anne Arundel County Public Schools (AACPS) to include in their RFP application. For these grant funds, AACPS is prioritizing the following areas:

- > Resource Navigation Services for Families
- Substance Use Prevention and Intervention
- > Behavioral Health Crisis Services and Urgent Care Services for Youth
  - > Parent Education on Behavioral Health Topics
  - > Educator Wellness and Mental Health Support
