

MARYLAND CONSORTIUM ON COORDINATED COMMUNITY SUPPORTS

The Maryland Consortium on Coordinated Community Supports was created by the General Assembly as part of the Blueprint for Maryland's Future. The Consortium is the entity responsible for developing a statewide framework to expand access to comprehensive behavioral health services for Maryland students.

The first Consortium Call for Proposals to expand access to student mental health services has been posted on their website.

To be considered for these grant funds with the Consortium, agencies must receive a letter of support from Wicomico County Public Schools (WCPS) to include in their application. For these grant funds, WCPS is prioritizing the following areas:

- Substance Use Prevention and Intervention
- Family Education on Behavioral Health Topics
- Behavioral Health Crisis Services and Urgent Care Services for Youth
 - Navigation Services for Families
 - Educator Wellness and Mental Health Training and Support
