Grant Awards, 2026-2027 School Year

The Maryland General Assembly created the Maryland Consortium on Coordinated Community Supports as part of the Blueprint for Maryland’s Future in recognition of the critical role that mental health and wraparound services play in supporting student achievement.

The Consortium is responsible for expanding access to comprehensive behavioral health services for Maryland students, pre-K through grade 12. As part of this mandate, the Consortium is funding new and expanded programming in all 24 jurisdictions; fostering collaboration between providers, schools, and families; and providing training and technical assistance in evidence-based approaches for clinicians and educators.

Following is an overview of the programs that will be implemented in year three of the program, the 2026-2027 school year. The programs are projected to serve more than 200,000 students.

TRACK 1 – Community Supports Partnerships

The Blueprint requires the Consortium to form local “Community Supports Partnerships” across the state. Using the collective impact model, each Partnership consists of a local coordinating body called a “Hub,” as well as the local community behavioral health providers. Hubs coordinate service providers in collaboration with schools. The fiscal year 2027 awards are supporting 14 Community Supports Partnerships covering 20 jurisdictions of the state.
