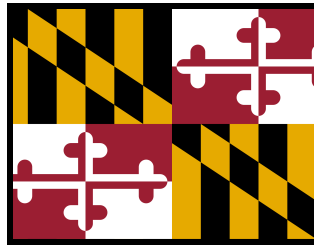

During the 2025-2026 funding year, 7 **Community Supports Partnerships** were established to oversee services in 12 Maryland counties within a statewide system in which community providers serve all 24 Maryland jurisdictions.

**91% of students** developed or improved a behavioral health skill.

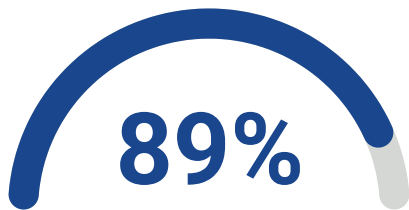
**4,509**
